
## Comprehensive Hearing Consultation

In a stationary sound booth, the patient's hearing acuity in each sound frequency band is tested, evaluated, and plotted using state-of-the-art audiometric testing equipment.



## Video Otoscopy

Our team views a live color image of the patient's ear canal and ear drum. It is used to detect developing conditions that could require medical attention. The video otoscope gives a clear picture of wax and its possible effect on the patient's hearing.




## Sound Field Test

Sound Field Testing is a special type of evaluation which measures the patient's hearing acuity in real world situations with and without hearing aids. Using specially calibrated equipment we are able to duplicate many types of listening situations, such as a noisy restaurant or a room where there are several conversations going on at the same time.



## Live Speech Mapping (Real Ear Measurement)

Live Speech Mapping is a new technology for fitting hearing aids that produces higher satisfaction. As the patient listens to live speech from a spouse or someone they are familiar with, an advanced computer measures and records the hearing aids' performance at the patient's eardrum. This system allows the clinician to precisely set and adjust the prescription for the best hearing possible.

## This is how speech sounds to people with hearing loss.

### Sensorineural Hearing Loss

This type of hearing loss, higher pitched tones may sound muffled.

### Conductive Hearing Loss

This type of hearing loss, occurs when there is an obstruction or damage to the outer or middle ear that prevents sound from traveling to the eardrum and tiny bones in the inner ear.

### Mixed Hearing Loss

This type of hearing loss, is a combination of conductive and sensorineural hearing loss.

There may be a problem in the outer or middle ear and in the inner ear or auditory nerve.
